Reasons to Oppose:

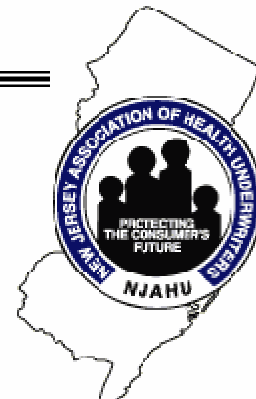
- This will be very difficult if not impossible to administer.
