Brief Description:

Establishes waiver, rebate or payment of insured's deductible, copayment, or coinsurance by health care practitioner as a form of insurance fraud subject to criminal and civil penalties.

Reasons to Oppose:

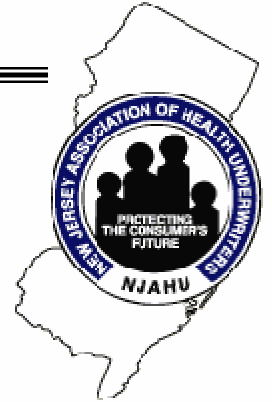
- Not seeing how this is enforceable.
